

# COMMANDER'S RISK REDUCTION TOOLKIT (CRRT)

# FACTSHEET

#### What is it?

The Army Commander's Risk Reduction Toolkit (CRRT) is a web-based tool that includes authoritative data sources displaying up to 40 risk factors (e.g., risk factors associated with health, demographics, deployments, legal affairs and substance abuse) to present command officials with a consolidated history of each Soldier's personal information and potential for high-risk behavior. The Army CRRT:

- Consolidates Soldier information from different databases into a single tool that unit command officials can directly access.
- Is an improved version of the former Commander's Risk Reduction Dashboard (CRRD) and is embedded within the new Army Vantage system, formerly known as the Army Leadership Dashboard.

### Who Can Use It?

- Access to Soldier information within CRRT is limited to Battalion and Company Commanders,
   Battalion and Company Command Sergeants Major, and Company First Sergeants.
- Authorized staff and officials at the brigade-level and above may access aggregate data for their respective commands and subordinate units within CRRT.

### **How Does It Work?**

- CRRT facilitates the analysis of trends and event relationships, which provides unit command officials with a composite picture of high-risk events.
- Within the toolkit, Commanders can filter dashboard content, export content, compare a unit's risk
  activity to Army standard risk behavior rates, review risk-event timelines, view unit hierarchies, and
  produce compliance documentation.
- Information gathered from the CRRT is used to improve communication, recommend appropriate
  interventions, target prevention activities, develop risk-reduction strategies, and monitor progress
  of improvement actions.
